

# 2023 CARHA Hockey World Cup Team Information Booklet March 19<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023 - Richmond, BC

### **General Information**

- The Host Hotel is the Sheraton Vancouver Airport Hotel. The CARHA Hockey World Cup
  Headquarters are located in the Elmbridge Room, and the Athletes Village is located in the Britannia
  Ballroom.
- All teams will be required to report to Headquarters upon arrival to register. Registration will be open from 4pm-8pm on March 18<sup>th</sup> and 10am-8pm on March 19<sup>th</sup>.
- All outstanding monies must be paid at registration or prior to your arrival
- All players will be expected to provide a credit card to the hotel for incidentals and services (i.e. room service). Without a credit card, access to such services will not be possible
- Players and participants recognize that all photos and videos shot during the Event are the property
  of CARHA Hockey World Cup and its partners and may be used on the web, social media and/or in
  any other CARHA Hockey World Cup promotion material and of its partners
- The tournament will be using a text messaging service to communicate important information throughout the week. We will ask all team representatives and alternate team representatives to subscribe to this service. More details will be provided on subscribing to this service directly.

- Teams participating in the Championship games who need to exchange their award for a different size can do so on **Sunday, March 26**<sup>th</sup> between **9:00am-12:00pm** at Headquarters
- CARHA Hockey World Cup merchandise will be available for purchase outside of the Athletes Village.
  Hours are 1pm-8pm on March 18<sup>th</sup>, 10am-8pm from March 20<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup>, 10am-4pm on March 23<sup>rd</sup>,
  and 10am-8pm on March 24<sup>th</sup>. Merchandise will also be available at the Opening and Closing
  Ceremonies, and Feature Game.
- We ask that all players represent themselves in a professional and cordial manner throughout the
  week. Should behavior be deemed unacceptable by the Tournament Organizing Committee, please
  note the participant may be expelled from the tournament without return compensation. This
  decision is at the sole discretion of the Tournament Organizing Committee

#### **Important Notes**

- All teams will be provided with a welcome package (which will be placed in each Team Representative's hotel room) and in this package will be a welcome gift - country jerseys and rally towels. We ask that all players and guests wear these jerseys and bring their towels to the Opening Ceremonies for the Athletes March!
- Also in your welcome package the official CARHA Hockey World Cup lanyard <u>must be worn at all times</u> to access bus transportation, to attend the socials and to be part of any other CARHA Hockey World Cup activities. On this lanyard you will see a QR code on the back this provides you with free access to the **Richmond Olympic Experience** a must see!
- Attached to the lanyards will be two white complimentary beer/wine tickets. These are only
  redeemable at the Opening Ceremonies at the Richmond Olympic Oval on Sunday, March 19<sup>th</sup>.



- Also attached to the lanyards will be two **blue** 'buy a round' beer tickets which are only redeemable at the Sheraton and Hilton before the Athletes March starts on **Sunday, March 19**<sup>th</sup>.
   Please remember to bring all 4 drink tickets to the Opening Ceremonies events.
- If you have purchased a ticket to the Opening or Closing Ceremonies as a local player this will be shown on your lanyard with a sticker. Circle = Opening Ceremonies and Star = Closing Ceremonies.
- Post-game gathering spots are available at each arena! Check out Stanley's Sports Bar & Grill at the Richmond Ice Centre and the CARHA Hockey Player's Pub at the Richmond Olympic Oval.
- All teams will also be provided with a Molson Passport in their welcome packages. As the proud Title Sponsor of the event, Molson Passport will be offering some great promotions and menu specials throughout the week, at locations included in the Passport

#### **Off-Ice Activities Information**

- The Athletes Village is located at the Sheraton Vancouver Airport Hotel in the Britannia Ballroom and will be open from Monday, March 20<sup>th</sup> to Friday March 24<sup>th</sup> from 11:00am-midnight. Food, drinks and entertainment every day!
- The Opening Ceremonies begin at 3:30pm at the Sheraton and Hilton. Participants staying at the
  River Rock and Radisson will be shuttled over and those from the Executive and Marriott will need
  to walk over to the Sheraton/Hilton. The Athletes March will begin from the hotel to the Richmond
  Olympic Oval. Please remember to wear your welcome jersey and bring your rally towel for this
  event.
- The Closing Ceremonies are at 6:00pm on Saturday, March 25<sup>th</sup> at the Richmond Olympic Oval all participants will be shuttled to the Oval from their hotel for this sit-down dinner and celebration.
- For those who have tickets to the Canucks game on **Thursday**, **March 23**<sup>rd</sup> transportation will be provided from the Sheraton. Arrive early for our **tailgating party** starting at **2pm**. Buses will begin leaving for the game at **5:30pm**. Please remember to **wear your welcome jersey** for this event.
- The **Feature Game** will be at **7:00pm** on **Friday, March 24**<sup>th</sup> at the Minoru Arena free shuttles for participants to watch will be available from the Sheraton starting at **6pm**. Be sure to sign up in advance.

# **Transportation Information**

- Transportation to and from the Vancouver Airport will be provided according to the travel itinerary
  information uploaded to each team's online profile. In the event a player/team misses their
  scheduled pick-up they would be responsible for arranging their own transportation to the hotel.
  For teams/participants who did not complete their travel itinerary, they too will be responsible for
  their own transportation
- Registered travelling participants will receive bus transportation to and from each of their games.
   Bus schedules will be posted in the hotel lobbies and will be provided digitally. All participants must be ready at their hotel lobby 10 minutes before the scheduled pickup. In the event a player/team misses their scheduled pickup they would be responsible for arranging their own transportation to the arena.
- Return transportation from games will be provided on a rotational basis not on a scheduled pick up.
   Players and guests can return to the hotel on any of the random/rotating shuttles when it arrives at the arena.
- A random shuttle will be operating for the duration of the tournament running from the hotels
  located near the airport to the Athletes' Village for players and guests it will be labelled ATHLETES
  VILLAGE. Another random shuttle will be operating for the duration of the tournament running from
  the hotels to the arenas labelled ARENAS.

#### **On-Ice Information**

- All tournament games will be played at the Richmond Ice Centre and the Richmond Olympic Oval with the exception of the Feature Game, which will be played at Minoru Arena
- Each arena will have its own Tournament Office should any questions or concerns arise
- All players must be able to present official photo identification (Passport or Driver's License) to the Tournament Organizing Committee if needed to confirm a player's age or identity
- After each tournament game, each player listed on the game sheet will receive a post-game refreshment ticket (beer/wine/pop), which is only redeemable in the Athletes Village prior to midnight on Friday, March 24<sup>th</sup>
